RETAIL FURLITURE REPORT FOR A RIL 1954

Instalment accounts outstanding at furniture stores continued to decline during April, the fourth month of declines from December's seasonal high. Balances outstanding at the end of the month were 1 per cent below the preceding month and 2 per cent below a year earlier. The collection ratio on instalment accounts of 12 per cent was 1 point below the March ratio and the same as April of last year.

Total sales at reporting furniture stores remained steady from March to April, but the different types of sales showed diverse movements. Instalment sales increased 1 per cent, while cash and charge-account sales decreased 3 per cent and 4 per cent, respectively. All types of sales continued below a year ago. For the first four months of the year, instalment sales were 13 per cent below the corresponding period a year ago, cash sales were down 9 per cent, and charge-account sales were down 6 per cent.

The retail value of furniture store inventories increased 2 per cent during April, but at the end of the month stocks were 9 per cent below a year earlier. At the April rate of sales, furniture store inventories amounted to about a 5 months' supply.
