RETAIL FURNITURE REEPORT FOR MARCH 1957

Instalment accounts outstanding at furniture stores continued to decline, and at the end of March were 2 per cent below the preceding month-end and 5 per cent below a year ago. Collections during the month amounted to 13 per cent of first-of-month balances, 1 point higher than both a month ago and a year ago.

Total sales at reporting furniture stores were up 5 per cent from February to March, reflecting increases of 8 per cent and I per cent in instalment and cash aales, reapectively; charge-account sales were down 3 per cent. Compared with a year ago, total sales declined 4 per cent. Sales volume for the first quarter of 1957 was also down 4 per cent from the corresponding period a year earlier.
