RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR MAY 1960

Total accounts receivable at reporting furniture stores were unchanged in May and about 3 per cent higher than in May 1959. Collections on instalment accounts remained at 12 per cent of the amount outstanding at the beginning of the month.

Sales at reporting stores increased 5 per cent in May and were slightly smaller in the first five months of 1960 than in the comparable period of 1959.
