## RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR JUNE 1962

Instalment accounts receivable of reporting furniture stores were unchanged in June and 1 per cent above the year-earlier level. Collections on these accounts were 12 per cent of the amount outstanding at the beginning of the month.

Total sales at reporting stores increased 3 per cent in June and were 5 per cent above the volume in June 1961.
