Instalment accounts raceivable of reporting furniture stores at the end of November were slightly above the amount outstanding at the end of October and about the same as a year earlier. The rate of collection on these accounts showed little change during the month.

Jales at reporting furniture stores increased further in Movember and were 4 per cent above those of a year earlier. Jash sales, which usually expand more rapilly than credit sales during the last marker of the year, were up 14 per cent during Movember. For the first 11 months of this year all types of sales showed substantial increases over 1961.
