RETAIL FURNITURE ROPORT FOR FEBRUARY 1963

Both instalment and charge accounts receivable of reporting furniture stores were smaller in Pebruary than in January but remained above year-earlier levels. Collection ratios on instalment accounts were unchanged. Cash and charge account sales declined in Pebruary while instalment sales showed no change.
