RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR DECEMBER 1963

Instalment accounts receivable at reporting furniture stores showed the customary year-end increase and, as in the preceding six months, were slightly larger than in the corresponding 1962 period. A seasonal slackening in collections brought the ratio to first-of-month receivables down one percentage point, to about the same rate as a year earlier.

Charge account balances, which also usually increase in December, were up eight per cent during the month but showed little change over December 1962, when an upswing of 6 per cent was recorded.

The December spurt in sales was the largest in several years. The gain was particularly marked in cash sales, which had slackened during November, but substantial increases occurred also in credit business. Sales of all types were larger than in December 1962. For the year 1963 as a whole, however, instelment sales were off somewhat, reflecting a comparatively low first half.
