RETAIL FURNITURE REPORT FOR JULY 1965

Instalment accounts receivable at reporting furniture stores were up slightly in July, a month in which little change is usual, and continued about 5 per cent above those of a year earlier. Collections during the month amounted to 12 per cent of the amount outstanding at the end of the preceding month.

Charge accounts outstanding declined by somewhat less than the usual seasonal amount and vere slightly above the amounts carried on the books on July 31 last year.

Total sales, which usually decline somewhat in July, showed little change from the June total. Cash sales of reporting stores declined by 1 per cent while instalment and charge account sales remained unchanged. Sales of all types were substantially larger than in the corresponding month last year, with credit volumes on both instalment and charge accounts showing somewhat larger gains than cash transactions.
