## Retail Instalment Credit

at Furniture, Household Appliance, and Jewelry Stores
February 1944

Instalment accounts outstanding at furniture and household appliance stores continued to decline in February at about the same rate as in January. Jewelry store accounts receivable were reduced by about the usual seasonal amount, and at the end of the month were 9 per cent below the year-ago level. At fumiture stores accounts outstanding rere 30 per cent below those on the corresponding date lest yeer, rs compared with a decline of 81 per cent at household appliance storos.

The February collection ratio on instalment accounts at household appliance stores remained unchanged at the January ratio oi 22 per cent. Collections during the month were 19 per cent of instalment accounts outstanding et the beginning of the month for furniture stores, and 32 per cent for jewelry stores.
