Instalment accounts outstanding at jewelry and household appliance. stores continued to decline in, May at about the same rate as in April. At the end of the month, the amount outstanding at jewelry stores was six per cent below that on the corresponding date last year. Furniture store accounts receivable showed about the usual seasonal increase, and by the end of May were about 24 per cent below the volume of a year ago.

Collections on instalment accounts during May increased at furniture. and jewelry stores. The collection ratio at furniture stores reached a new high of 25 per cent, while at jewelry stores the ratio rose two points to 30 per cent. Collections at household appliance stores during ley were 25 per cent of instalment accounts outstanding at the beginning of the month.
