Retail Instalment Credit at Furniture and Household Appliance Stores

JANUARY 1952

Instalment accounts outstanding at furniture stores decreased seasonally in January. Balances at the month-end were about 5 per cent below those of the preceding month and about 6 per cent below the level of a year ago.

Household appliance store instalment accounts outstanding also showed a seasonal decline during the month, bringing the total to a level about 2 per cent below that of December. Fonth-ond balances continued substantially below those of a year ago.

The January collection ratio for both furniture and household appliance stores was unchanged from December. It was also unchanged from a year ago for household appliance stores; however, the January ratio for furniture stores was one point above that of a year ago.
