FEBRUARY 1946

Instalment accounts outstanding at department stores declined by less than the usual seasonal amount, and were eight per cent larger than a year earlier. Collections on instalment accounts were reduced 11 per cent, and the collection ratio declined two points to 30 per cent. The average period instalment accounts were outstanding was approximately five and one-half months, about the same length of time as in February last year.

Charge accounts receivable declined less than seasonally in February and were nearly one-fifth higher than on the corresponding date of 1945. Collections on charge accounts decreased sharply, as is usual in February, resulting in a collection ratio of 60 per cent, one point less than in January. Charge accounts were collected in bout 50 days, about the same average as for February

Both types of credit Sales increased substantially during February, and were approximately one-fourth greater than in the corresponding month last year. Cash sales, accounting for 61 per cent of the total, showed a slight increase over the January volume, but were 18 per cent larger than a year ago.
