DEPARTMENT STORE CHEDIT - APRIL 1954

Instalment accounts outstanding at department stores remained steady during April after three months of decrease from the seasonal high reached in December. Balances at the end of the month were 7 per cent above a year ago. The April collection ratio on instalment accounts decreased 1 point to 11 per cent, the same ratio as a year earlier.

Charge accounts outstanding at the end of April were 4 per cent above the preceding month and 8 per cent above a year ago. The charge-account collection ratio, 45 per cent, was 3 points below the Earch ratio and 1 point below April of last year.

Cash and charge-account sales increased ll per cent and 16 per cent, respectively, from harch to April, while instalment sales increased l per cent. Compared with a year ago, cash sales were up l per cent, charge-account sales 9 per cent, and instalment sales 3 per cent. These favorable comparisons with both month-ago and year-ago figures, however, reflect in part the relatively late date of Easter.
