Instalment accounts outstanding at department stores at the end of June were down slightly from the level of the preceding month. Compared with a year ago, however, amounts outstanding were up 7 per cent. The ratio of instalment collections to first-of-month balances was $1 i_{4}$ per cent, 1 point less than both a month ago and a year a no.

Charge accounts receivable also declined from May to June, When some decrease is usual, but continued 2 per cent above the corresponding month last year. Collections on charge accounts amounted to 46 per cent of balances outstanding on the first of the month, the sane ratio as was reported in the preceding month and in June last year.

At reporting department stores, both cash and credit sales declined moderately from lay to June. Cash and charge-account sales wei also less than in the same morin of 1956; instalment, sales, however, were up 1 per cent.
