DEPAKTMENT STORE CREDIT - APRIL 1961

Instalnent accounts recoivable of roporting dopartment stores declined slightly in April and at the month-ond vere 2 per cent abovo those of a yeer corlier. The rate of repayment on accounts outotanding at the besiniling of the month was approximately the same as for the firat two ronths of the year but was below the accelerated March rato.

Charge accounts outstanding showed little chance during April. The decline over the year-period wad due, in part, to the dilferences in Easter dates. In fpril charge accounts were collected leos rapidly than in the precoding ronth but at about the same rate as in the correspondins ronth of 1960.

Departmont store sales of all typea, which are not. adjusted for differences in buginoss days, showed a post-Easter decline in April pollowing a nonth of marked increase. Declines were due principally to seasonal changes in cash and chargeaccount sales. Sales of all types vere below those of a year earlier.
