DEFARITIENI STORE CREDIT - JULY 1962
Instalment accounts receivable of reporting department stores declined 2 per cent in July but continued above the year-earlier level.. Collections on these accounts were 16 per cent of the amount outstanding at the beginning of the month, a somewhat slower collection rate than in June but 2 percentage points above the rate in July 1961.

Charge accounts receivable declined 8 per cent. in July but were 4 per cent above the level of July 1961. Collections on these accounts were 47 per cent of outstandings at the beginning of the month.

Sales declined seasonally in July but were 4 per cent above the year-earlier volume. The July decline was more marked for cash sales than for either charge or instalment sales. All types of sales shared in the year-to-year gain.
