Credit, Consumer 9, 1969 OF RICHMOND CONSUMER INSTALMENT CREDIT AT COMMERCIAL BANKS\*

NOVEMBER 1968

Consumer instalment credit outstanding at commercial banks amounted to \$36,560 million on November 30, \$208 million above the revised end of October figure. All types of credit increased during the month with automobile credit accounting for about half of the total expansion.

Loans made during November, which customarily fall below the October volume, were down \$429 million during the month this year. Year-to-year gains were recorded for all major types of credit and in every section of the country.
