CONSTINER INSTALMENT CREDIT AT COMMERCIAL BANKS

MAY 1969

Consumer instalment credit outstanding at commercial banks at the end of May amounted to \$38,347 million, an increase of \$493 million during the month and of \$4,268 million over the year-period. All types of credit and all sections of the country shared in the expansion.

The volume of credit extended in May, which customarily shows little change, decreased \$149 million during the month this year. The amount extended, however, was larger than in May 1968 for every major type of credit.
