CONSUMER INSTALMENT CREDIT AT COMMERCIAL BANKS
JANUARY 1972

Commercial bank extensions of consumer instalment credit showed the usual post-holiday contraction during January and declined \$657 million from December. Although volume was lower in all types of credit, the largest reduction-\$291 million-coccurred in bank credit card use. Automobile credit reflected a seasonal drop in new car sales and decreased \$111 million from December; however, auto extensions were nearly \$300 million above the unusually low level of January 1971.

Instalment credit outstanding at commercial banks declined approximately \$100 million from December to January. Reductions totaling \$142 million in such major types of credit as automobile paper, credit cards, and home repair loans were partially offset by gains of \$44 million in mobile home credit outstanding and \$17 million in personal loans.
