SALES FINANCE COMPANIES

MAY 1963

Outstanding consumer instalment credit at sales finance companies totaled \$12,583 million at the end of May, \$77 million more than a month earlier. Retail automobile paper increased \$139 million. Other consumer goods paper, however, declined \$78 million. Personal loans showed a slight rise while repair and modernization loans showed no change from April.

Consumer credit at the end of May was \$1,143 million, or 10 per cent, higher than in May, 1962. Retail passenger automotive paper accounted for almost 70 per cent of this rise.

Extensions of consumer credit, at \$1,107 million, were \$13 million above April and \$48 million higher than May, 1962. Extensions of credit at retail on passenger cars increased \$11 million in May in comparison to \$104 million in April.

Business credit increased \$57 million in May, totaling \$5,704 million at month-end. Wholesale automotive paper declined \$7 million.
