

Consumer credit held by Sales Finance Companies at the end of June showed a $\$ 214$ million increase over May. Retail automotive paper contributed almost two-thirds of this expansion. Other consumer goods and personal loans rose $\$ 46$ million and $\$ 33$ million respectively.

Total extensions in June were 12.4 per cent above the previous month, and much of this reflected an increase in retail automotive extensions.

Business credit expanded $\$ 116$ million, due almost entirely to an increase in wholesale automotive paper.
