Consumer instalment credit outstanding at sales finance companies increased \$130 million in December, the eleventh consecutive monthly advance. All major categories of credit except repair and modernization loans contributed to this greater than seasonal rise. However, the increases in extensions were less than seasonal for all major groups, holding the total rise in extensions of consumer instalment paper during December to \$187 million.

For the fourth quarter, consumer instalment credit outstanding at sales finance companies increased \$438 million, somewhat less than in the fourth quarter of 1968; for the year ended December 31, 1969, the increase amounted to \$1,579 million. All major categories of credit contributed to the over-the-year advance except repair and modernization loans which dipped \$9 million.
