FEBRUARY 1970

Consumer instalment credit outstanding at sales finance companies dipped \$51 million in February. Retail passenger car paper showed a greater than seasonal decline, while other consumer goods paper registered a greater than seasonal increase. The decline in personal loans outstanding was mainly seasonal.

Total consumer instalment credit extensions dropped \$29 million below January. All the major categories of credit contributed to this greater than seasonal decline.

Business credit outstanding increased \$217 million in February, with wholesale automotive paper accounting for most of the rise. Business credit extensions increased \$124 million, a drop of \$240 million from a year ago.
