SALES FINANCE COMPANIES

MAY 1970

Consumer instalment credit outstanding at sales finance companies rose \$88 million in May to a total of \$19,760 million. Retail passenger car credit outstanding showed a smaller than seasonal increase, while the other major categories of credit registered seasonal increases.

Credit extended by sales finance companies dipped \$51 million below last month due to declines in passenger car and personal loan paper.

Business credit outstandings increased \$203 million in May, with all the major categories of business credit contributing to the rise.
