

Consumer instalment credit outstanding at sales finance companies rose $\$ 88$ million in May to a total of $\$ 19,760$ million. Retail passenger car credit outstanding showed a smaller than seasonal increase, while the other major categories of credit registered seasonal increases.

Credit extended by sales finance companies dipped $\$ 51$ million below last. month due to declines in passenger car and personal loan paper.

Business credit outstandings increased $\$ 203$ million in May, with all the major categories of business credit contributing to the rise.
