SALES FINANCE COMPANIES - Sales

JULY 1970

Consumer instalment credit outstanding at sales finance companies declined \$349 million in July. Retail passenger car paper and other consumer goods paper outstanding registered greater than seasonal declines while personal loans showed a seasonal increase.

Total consumer instalment credit extensions dipped \$72 million this month. Retail passenger car paper and personal loans accounted for this decline. Total extensions this July increased \$64 million from a year ago, with only other consumer goods paper and personal loans contributing to this increase.

Business credit outstanding dropped \$181 million in July with all the categories of credit, except other business credit, registering declines.
