COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in all districts and a net of \$630 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended March 18, reflecting primarily quarterly tax date needs. All categories showed net increases except for small decreases in bankers' acceptances and in loans to commodity dealers and to petroleum refiners.

The larger net increases were \$109 million in loans to the retail trade, \$64 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$51 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, and \$50 million to "all other" types of business concerns.

The outstanding loans and changes during the week and since year-end are shown below; fourth column shows the changes during the comparable period last year.
