COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$15 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended June 10.

The principal net increases were \$30 million in loans to the construction industry, \$24 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$21 million to manufacturers of "other" fabricated metal products, and \$26 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest net decreases were \$47 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products and \$35 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities.

The outstanding loans and changes during the week and since year-end are shown below; fourth column shows the changes during the comparable period last year.
