COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$651 million at weekly reporting member banks in all districts during the week ended June 17. All categories, except bankers' acceptances, showed net increases reflecting quarterly tax date needs.

The principal net increases were \$120 million in loans to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, \$77 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$59 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$50 million to the retail trade and \$47 million to "all other" types of business concerns.

The outstanding loans and changes during the week and since year-end are shown below; fourth column shows the changes during the comparable period last year.
