## H.12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$13 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended August 26.

The principal net decreases were \$33 million in loans to retail trade, \$16 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$15 million in bankers' acceptances, and \$15 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest net increase was \$45 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities.

The outstanding loans and changes during the week and since mid-year are shown below; fourth column shows the changes during the comparable period last year.
