COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$370 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended December 30.

The principal net increases were \$155 million in loans to the mining industry, which includes producers of petroleum and natural gas, \$150 million to "all other" types of business concerns, \$104 million to petroleum refiners, \$92 million to transportation, communications, and other public utilities, and \$46 million to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber products.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$128 million to retail trade.

The outstanding loans and changes during the week and since mid-year are shown below; fourth column shows the changes during the comparable period last year.
