COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in eleven districts and a net of \$1,171 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended March 17, reflecting primarily quarterly tax date needs. All categories showed net increases except loans to a commodity dealers.

The larger net increases were \$219 million in loans to retail trade, \$168 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$101 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, and \$159 million to unclassified borrowers.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since year-end and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
