COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in eleven districts and a net of \$1,171 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended March 17, reflecting primarily quarterly tax date needs. All categories showed net increases except loans to commodity dealers.

The larger net increases were \$219 million in loans to retail trade, \$168 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$101 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, and \$159 million to unclassified borrowers.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since year-end and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
