H. 12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in eight districts and a net of \$129 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended April 14.

The principal net increases were \$54 million in loans to the construction industry, \$38 million to manufacturers of "other" fabricated metal products, \$37 million to retail trade, \$36 million to unclassified borrowers and \$33 million to "all other" types of business concerns.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$58 million in loans to commodity dealers, \$48 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, and \$40 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since year-end and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
