H. 12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$185 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended May 12.

The principal net increases were \$57 million in loans in bankers' acceptances, \$34 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$28 million to the construction industry, \$27 million to manufacturers of "other" fabricated metal products, and \$33 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$61 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since year-end and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
