COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$13 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended June 9.

The principal net decreases were \$74 million in loans to retail trade, \$33 million in bankers' acceptances, \$24 million to commodity dealers, and \$22 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$49 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$22 million to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products, and \$21 million to manufacturers of "other" durable goods.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since year-end and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
