*- H. 12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in nine districts and a net of \$130 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended August 11.

The principal net increases were \$34 million in loans to manufacturers of "other" fabricated metal products, \$32 million to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products, \$23 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment, and \$56 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$80 million in loans to retail trade.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since mid-year and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
