COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$274 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended August 18.

The principal net increases were \$77 million in loans to retail trade, \$26 million to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products, \$24 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$19 million each to manufacturers of "other" nondurable goods, and to the construction industry, and \$54 million to "all other" types of business concerns.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since mid-year and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
