H. 12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased in eight districts and a net of \$149 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended October 20.

The principal net decreases were \$58 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products, \$35 million to retail trade, \$25 million to manufacturers of machinery, and \$65 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$64 million in loans to commodity dealers, and \$44 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since mid-year and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
