## COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in all districts and a net of \$1,252 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended March 16, reflecting quarterly tax date needs. All categories showed net increases except for a nominal decrease in loans in bankers' acceptances.

The principal net increases were \$134 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$133 million to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber products, \$94 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$93 million to retail trade, \$87 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, and \$111 million to unclassified borrowers.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since year-end and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
