COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$58 million at weekly reporting member banks during the week ended May 11.

The principal net increases were \$60 million in loans to manufacturers of primary metals, \$24 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$23 million to petroleum refiners, and \$29 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$42 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment, and \$32 million to commodity dealers.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since year-end and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
