## H. 12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$319 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 24.

The principal net decreases were \$96 million in loans to retail trade, \$60 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, \$38 million to other wholesale, and \$104 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$50 million in loans to "all other" types of business concerns.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since mid-year and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
