COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$179 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 5.

The principal net increases were \$94 million in loans to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, \$82 million to retail trade, \$65 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and \$43 million to manufacturers of machinery.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$38 million in loans to the mining industry, which includes producers of petroleum and natural gas, \$33 million to manufacturers of other fabricated metal products, and \$51 million to unclassified borrowers.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since mid-year and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
