## COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in ten districts and a net of \$196 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 2.

The principal net increases were \$126 million in loans to retail trade, \$96 million to transportation, communication, and other public utilities, \$65 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and \$55 million to commodity dealers.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$60 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, and \$62 million to unclassified borrowers.

Outstanding loans and changes from a week ago and a year ago are shown below; cumulative changes since mid-year and during the comparable period last year are shown in the last two columns.
