COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$287 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 1.

The principal net increases were \$113 million in loans in bankers' acceptances, \$91 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$66 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$56 million to "all other" types of business concerns, and \$41 million to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$75 million in loans to the mining industry, which includes producers of petroleum and natural gas, and \$53 million to "other" public utilities.
