## H.12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased in eight districts and a net of \$164 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 29.

The principal net decreases were \$120 million in loans to retail trade, \$56 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and \$41 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$21 million in loans to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber products, and \$29 million to unclassified borrowers.
