COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in eleven districts and a net of \$905 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 14. All categories of classified loans showed net increases, except three, reflecting quarterly tax date needs.

The principal net increases were \$147 million in loans to petroleum refiners, \$111 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$102 million to "other" public utilities, and \$99 million to the mining industry, which includes producers of petroleum and natural gas.
