COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in all districts and a net of \$1,477 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 21.

The principal net increases were \$291 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$179 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$155 million to "other" public utilities, \$140 million to retail trade, and \$100 million to communication.
