COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in eight districts and a net of \$254 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended July 5.

The principal net increases were \$88 million in loans to "other" public utilities, \$58 million to communication, \$45 million to manufacturers of primary metals, and \$88 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$34 million in loans to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber products.
