## H.12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$546 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 9.

The principal net decreases were \$179 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$91 million to retail trade, and \$47 million in bankers' acceptances and "other" public utilities.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$23 million in loans to commodity dealers, and \$21 million to the manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products.
